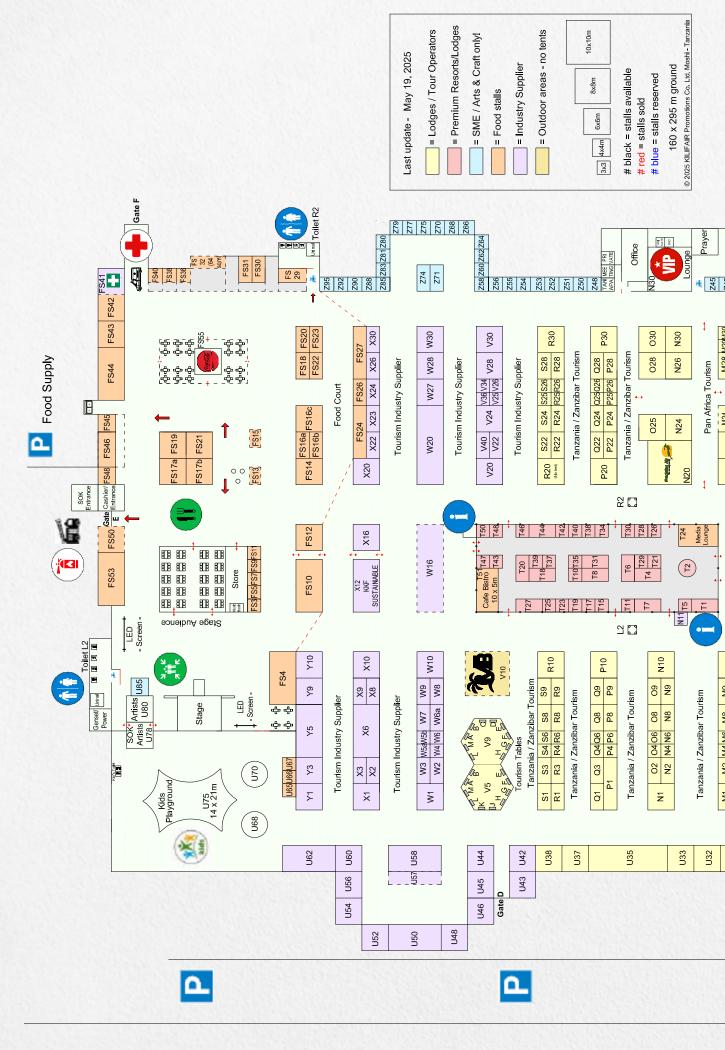

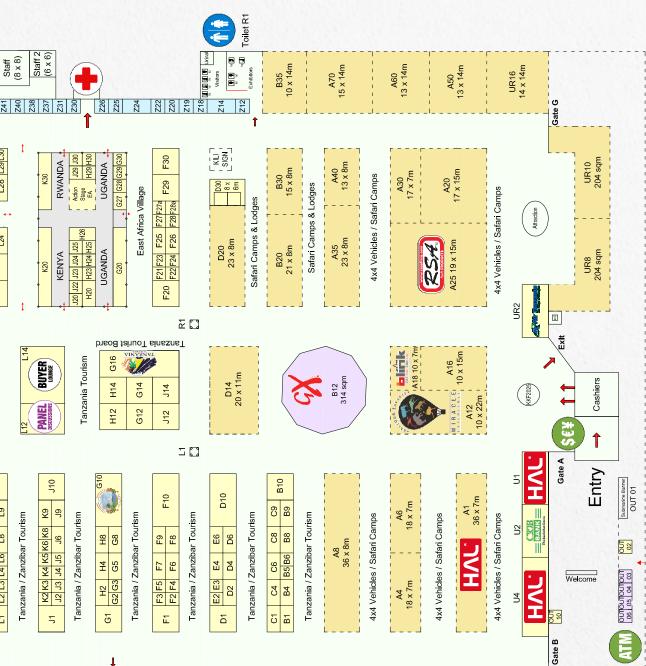

DISCOVER THE LAND OF A THOUSAND HILLS

AKAGERA NATIONAL PARK - HOME TO THE BIG 5

Founded in 1934, Akagera National Park is Central Africa's largest protected wetland and the last remaining refuge for savannahadapted species in Rwanda and home to the famous Big 5 game (lions, leopards, buffaloes, rhinos and elephants).

It is named after the Agakera River that flows along its eastern boundary and feeds into a labyrinth of lakes of which the largest is lake Ihema. A boat trip on lakes Ihema and Rwanyakizinga is also a highlight of any visit to Akagera, with its large pods of hippos, Nile crocodiles and abundant birdlife.

Enjoy thrilling day and night game drives, scenic boat safaris on Lake Ihema and Rwanyakizinga, a breathtaking hot air balloon experience, and luxurious stays at Magashi Camp by Wilderness.

RWANDA'S CULTURAL HERITAGE CORRIDOR

Rwanda has a rich history that precedes colonial time and a tour of our museum will reveal just that. Located in Rwanda's Southern Province, this region showcases a number of Rwanda's important cultural and historical sites.

A replica of the traditional royal residence, the King's Palace Museum is a beautifully-crafted thatched dwelling shaped like a beehive. In the olden days, Nyanza was a heart of Rwanda.



For a long time, the monarchy was mobile, moving the court between various locations and when it eventually settled in one place, Nyanza was the obvious choice.

This museum offers a detailed look into the Rwandan traditional seat of the old monarchy. It was restored to its 19th century and made entirely with traditional materials.



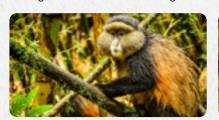
NYUNGWE NATIONAL PARK

One of Africa's oldest rainforests, Nyungwe is rich in biodiversity and spectacularly beautiful. A quarter of all of Africa's primates, 13 species, a re found here, including the common chimpanzee.

It is also a birder's paradise with around 300 recorded species, nearly 30 of which are endemic to the Albertine Rift region with several plant species such as orchids. In 2021, 1277 hectares of indigenous forest regeneration was assisted through the removal of exotic plants. With plenty of rainfall, Nyungwe is also the major catchment area in Rwanda, and supplies water to 70% of the country.

A ridge running through the forest forms a watershed between the drainage systems of the Nile and the Congo. A spring on the slopes of Mt Bigugu is said to be the furthest source of the Nile, the world's longest river.

Experience primate tracking, a thrilling Canopy Walkway, birdwatching, scenic hiking and waterfall trails, along with unforgettable moments at Magashi Camp by Wilderness.
